We exist to promote amateur radio, serve our members, educate the community, and be a resource for our served agencies; Skywarn and our local Amateur Radio Emergency Services (ARES) group.

Our primary repeater, using the club call sign K8EEN, is:

146.790 MHz, -600 MHz with a PL of 71.9 Hz.

444.600 MHz, +5 MHz with a PL of 71.9 Hz.
